Dear Parents / Carers,

At Norbridge Academy, many of our children choose to travel to school via a bike or scooter. Although this is something that we encourage, as this is an eco-friendlier way of travelling to school, we have noticed that the safety of our community is not always being taken into consideration.

If your child is travelling to school on a scooter or a bike, we would like to politely remind you that they **must not** ride the bike or scooter on the school grounds. This includes all pathways, playgrounds (including the Early Years Foundation Unit) and car parks. Once children arrive at the school entrance, they must push the bike/scooter into school. The same applies when children are leaving the school site.

We have a bike/scooter shed on the Key Stage 1 playground, where children can store these, but please know that these are left at your own risk.

We kindly ask that you adhere to this safety requirement, so that we can continue to allow children to travel to school on a bike or scooter.
